
CONTINUUM OF CARE PROGRAM

Through our Continuum of Care program at SAVIS of Halton, we support and provide services for survivors of, and folks at risk of, human trafficking.



Case Management

Using feminist principles and an anti-racist anti-oppression lens, SAVIS offers comprehensive case management and trauma-informed support to survivors of human trafficking



Crisis Support

Our Crisis Support Workers assist survivors with safety planning, stabilization, short-term goalsetting and crisis intervention



Housing Support

SAVIS has crisis units for survivors of human trafficking. We also facilitate access to transitional housing and we support survivors in applying for housing subsidies, joining waitlists, finding private market rentals, or looking for safe, temporary shelters



Because of them I've had the privilege of being able to wake up knowing I'm safe and that they wholeheartedly believe in me to be so."

They helped me achieve shelter and advocated for me during the court where if it wasn't for their support I would not get my son back. They also advocated for me when I was able to get out of the shelter and in our first home. They bought us beds and other things that I could not afford. I have never felt alone with their support. I was transferred to another agency. I never received any support where your organization offered to come back into my life. They continue to help me become an independent member of society and I never feel alone.
