## Accompaniments

SAVIS staff and trained volunteers are available to provide accompaniments to criminal court, Nina's Place and police stations after incidents of sexual violence. While we cannot speak on your behalf, we will ensure you are being treated in a dignified way, offer information to demystify the legal and medical process and provide you with emotional support.

## Counselling Program

SAVIS offers FREE individual counselling throughout the Halton Region to ALL survivors of abuse. Qualified counsellors are available to support you through your healing journey. SAVIS offers non-directive, non-judgmental, confidential counselling services. Language interpretation services are available for all clients. Counselling is available in Milton, Georgetown, Burlington, Acton and Oakville.

If you have experienced sexual violence recently, attending court, or experiencing an acute crisis, emergency counselling sessions are available.

## Service for Men

Male-identified survivors and male-identified supporters of survivors of sexual assault and violence are welcome to access the individual counselling program for up to 24 sessions. Sessions are scheduled in a way as to ensure that male-identified and female-identified and clients do not share waiting room space.

## Public Education

Education can make a difference in our goal to end all forms of violence. SAVIS currently offers different public education workshops to schools, community members and agencies in Halton. As part of our commitment to education, there is no cost associated with this service and each topic can be modified to suit the needs of the group.
